- In partnership with SC Johnson, we are working toward *Healthier Camp Communities*
- Project will launch as a pilot study in the state of Wisconsin
- This presentation will outline the **requirements** for participation and the **resources and support** being provided to pilot camps



As a pilot site, we ask for...

1. Your participation in TickWise education offered prior to camp (Online course, Webinars)
2. Camps to provide specified tick education as part of staff training (online course, educational documents, onsite training)
3. Sharing of tick educational information with families, caregiver, and campers prior to arrival at camp (Camper/Family Education Infographic, Brochure)
4. Collection of data regarding prevention activities, tick encounters, tick bites, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP), and subsequent treatment if provided.
5. Collection of evaluation data from camp leaders and staff regarding the pilot experience
6. Potential participation in highlight video of the project
7. Commitment to support program growth in subsequent years

Alliance for Camp Health will Provide...



1. Pre-camp education regarding ticks and tick prevention activities
2. Consultation and training to help prepare camps for the pilot project
3. Potential funding for subsequent years involvement in the project
4. Tracking forms to document ticks, tick bites, prevention activities, PEP, and follow up treatment if needed.
5. Educational materials for families, caregivers, and campers
6. Data collection and research related to ticks at camp
7. Health Hotline to support camps during summer season
8. Exploring opportunities for repellent use at camp
